TO BE ELIGIBLE, the applicant must have compiled either an overall unweighted high school GPA of 3.0 or an overall weighted high school GPA of 3.25 and attend a public, private, charter, or virtual high school in Calhoun, Franklin, Gadsden, Gulf, Jackson, Jefferson, Leon, Liberty, Madison, Suwannee, or Wakulla county. The applicant does NOT have to play a high school sport to qualify.

Please mail a high-quality headshot photo and, if you wish, up to 4 photos with captions explaining the specific activity (school, organization, sports, religious, or community activity) in which you are engaging during the time the photo is taken. Include your name and school on the photo. The headshot photo is used for projecting your image on the video screen for banquet patrons to view. Please do not forget to enclose a good-quality headshot photograph.
